Currently, he is General Manager of COTEC, a Foundation created by more than 50 Spanish companies for promoting the technological innovation in the Spanish industry.

He has been on the Board of Directors of the following firms: Intelsa, Comet, AT&T Microelectronics in Spain and Amper Programas.

During his academic career and his initial years in the business world, he wrote approximately 30 technical articles published in Spanish and international journals in the field of electronics, specifically related to semiconductor devices. Later his publications dealt with telecommunications and often with R+D and technological innovation management.
